Kingdom Building!

Imagine living with your family in the make-shift tent structure in the picture above. It illustrates the living condition of some families in El Zorrillo, Mexico (near Ensenada), and it represents an opportunity for God's people to step up to help.

Since 2010, our church family has been part of a house building mission in to El Zorrillo called, "Club Quest." They have built over 45 houses so far. Each house incurs an \$8,000.00 cost and our congregation, led by Mark Whittaker, has covered the cost for 10 houses and has helped to send 23 workers to pitch in and build those houses from the foundation up.

But there is more to this mission than building houses. It is a kingdombuilding effort rooted in our partnership with the El Zorrillo church of Christ. Each family for whom a house is built has the rich opportunity to turn their hearts to Jesus and become a part of His church. Many have done just that. And just as the workers follow a master plan for the house, the local church points each family to God's master plan for the Christian home.

Those who use a week's vacation to go work can expect to be deeply blessed by worshipping with the local church on Wednesday night. You don't have to understand Spanish to grasp the gratitude in their hearts and the praise they offer to God. Worship transcends language. And after a week of work, the keys to a 3-room, wood-framed, insulated house is given to a grateful family. And that's not all! A bible, a table, a few chairs, some basic foods, a broom, and a dustpan are also presented.

Today is the last day for adding to our special contribution on behalf of this mission. Let God lead your hearts as He wills. We know it's nice to have a good roof over our heads, but King David sang out to God about something even better:

• "Let me take refuge in the shelter of Your wings." (Psalm 61:4)
