Recalling the “days of Lot” (Abraham’s nephew), Jesus said, “...they were eating, they were drinking, they were buying, they were selling, they were planting, and they were building” (Luke 17:28). Jesus then reminded His followers that fire and brimstone rained from heaven and destroyed them all.

Jesus was not against eating, drinking, buying, selling, and so on. He was warning that a day of destruction could come when least expected. Some 2,000 years before Christ, Lot and his family were the only Sodomites saved from the destruction of that sinful city. An angel warned Lot, “Escape for your life! Do not look behind you!” (Genesis 19:17).

While escaping, however, Lot’s wife looked back and became a pillar of salt. Thinking of her fate, Jesus then put the gospel in a powerful nutshell, saying, “Whoever strives to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will keep it.” (vs. 33). In short, when God gives you a new lease on real life, let go of the old life and don’t look back. Make a clean break with sin!



The apostle Paul was forward, not backward, looking. He wrote, “...forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.” (Philippians 3:13-14)
