Live and Learn: The Rocky Road to Wisdom



This 1818 painting is titled, "***Wanderer Above the Sea of Fog,***" by Caspar David Friedrich (1774–1840), a German Romantic landscape painter. This artist often featured contemplative figures silhouetted against dark or misty skies. Sometimes his silhouettes are set in old cemeteries, among Gothic ruins, or amid barren trees. In this painting, we see a man on a mountaintop. The hiker is being rewarded for his climb with an awesome view. With walking stick in hand and some wind in his hair, the main message in this masterpiece is that his journey through the fog toward wisdom is worth it.

On Sunday, September 4th, a new Bible class for young adults is starting in our church library titled, "***Love and Learn: the Rocky Road to Wisdom.***" Join in at 9:45 am. The main message is that wisdom is well worth pursuing. God's word tells us where this journey begins:
