

If you fold up this bulletin, put it in your Bible and leave it there, a descendant of yours may find it while going through your old things. With that slight possibility in mind, I would like to say something to a future reader.

Dear **2072** Reader,

Hello from the distant past! The old Bible in your hands once belonged to a member of our church—the Lewiston Church of Christ. This means that he or she began their journey of faith with a repentant heart, aware of their need to be forgiven of their sins. They believed that Jesus was sent by His heavenly Father (God) to become sin on our behalf. Unfair as that was for Him, it was God's plan and Jesus' choice. His death on the cross for our redemption was followed by His resurrection from the dead. Each member of our church embraced Jesus' death and resurrection not just with words but by dying to ourselves in a water grave and trusting in God for a newness of life that could only be lived through the Holy Spirit. This made us a family of faith that enjoyed mutual fellowship and Christian love.

In 2022, not all churches took this book in your hands seriously. We did.
