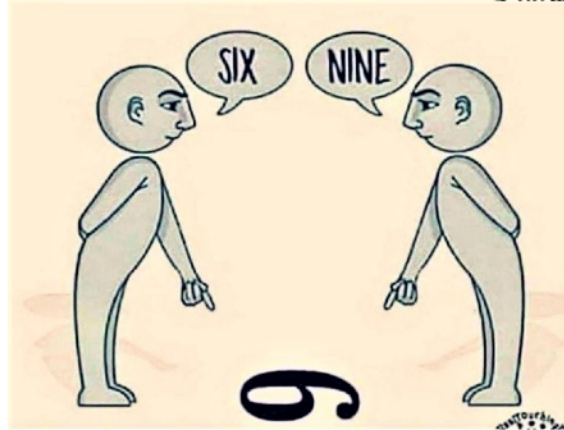

## “True or Not”

Do not be misled by the cartoon above. Truth is much more than a shape or a symbol. The real numbers 6 and 9 are not actually interchangeable, regardless of how you think you perceive them.

Personal perception is easy. Reality, however, requires hard work and discipline to pursue. First, admit your perception is only a small part of the full picture. Then get outside yourself and search for truth with humble tenacity.

In a July 23rd White House phone call to Ashraf Ghani, then the president of Afghanistan, Joe Biden expressed concern that the perception around the world was that things were not going well in the fight against the Taliban. He added, “whether it is true or not, there is a need to project a different picture.”
