## *“Fulfill It!”*

*“Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it.”*  
~ The Apostle Paul (Colossians 4:17)

Paul’s letter to the Colossians is awesome. It presents Jesus Christ as...

- The firstborn of all creation (1:15)
- Creator of all things (1:16)
- Holding all things together (1:17)
- The Head of the body (1:18)
- The fullness of God (1:19)
- Reconciler of all things... (1:20)

Paul goes on to repeatedly proclaim that Jesus was raised from the dead. Thus, He lives and we are called to walk worthy of Him. On **Wednesday nights**, the adults are in Colossians chapter two and going strong. Join us at 6:30 pm. But right here and now, I want to skip to the end of Colossians where Paul issued a profound challenge to one **Archippus**, whom he saved for last.

In his letter to Philemon, Paul called Archippus a “fellow soldier” (vs. 2). Perhaps he was part of Philemon’s house church. We don’t know much about Archippus, but if you belong to the Lewiston Church of Christ, you have something crucial in common with him. As a disciple, Archippus received a ministry from the Lord. As a member of Jesus’ church, so have you. Thus, Paul’s final challenge to Archippus (quoted above and below) is a purposeful challenge for you and me, here and now:

- *“Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it.”* (Colossians 4:17)
