Honest Expectations

When you are baptized into Christ, He adds you to His church. But it's still up to you to seek out a home congregation where you can worship God, grow in faith, and serve in His kingdom. Don't expect perfection but here are five basic expectations that should be met before you commit to a local congregation:

- They must look to Jesus Christ as their Head.
- Repentance & forgiveness of sins through Christ is preached.
- · Brotherly love within the church family is pursued.
- · Godly concern for the local community is crucial.
- Members can confess failures and are challenged to overcome them.

But what is good for the Christian goose is good for the church gander. Here are five commitments a local congregation should expect of you:

- Commit yourself to regular worship and fellowship: "[Let] us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together..." (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Commit yourself to <u>regular prayer</u> and <u>Bible study</u>: "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)
- Commit yourself to identifying and <u>cultivating spiritual gifts</u>: "Since you are eager to possess spiritual gifts, strive to excel for the edification of the church." (1 Corinthians 14:12)
- Commit yourself to <u>gracious cheerful giving</u>: "Each one must do just as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7).
- Commit yourself to living by the Golden Rule: "So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you." (Matthew 7:12)
