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

I get frustrated when my body refuses to respond to my commands like it once did.

I get frustrated when I hear the IRS was hacked making honest tax-payers vulnerable to identity theft.

I get frustrated when I see news reports of flash mobs ransacking a store with impunity.

This is an abbreviated list. To be sure, Christian faith does not prevent frustration. But faith can show us a bigger picture that puts our frustrations into proper perspective.
